A Day in the Park

As a City of Austin park managed daily by Waterloo Greenway Conservancy, Waterloo Park is open daily for all to visitors from 5am-10pm. In 2022, we welcomed an estimated 70,000 annual visitors during typical park days, outside of our special events. Waterloo Greenway's Operations team worked hard to keep our 11 acres thriving with a healthy landscape. Waterloo Park's Great Lawn underwent annual landscaping maintenance, with weekly planting and arbor care. Biannual tree inspections gave care to Waterloo Park's transplanted trees, including four heritage live oaks originally located from the Texas Capitol grounds, University of Texas, and nearby developments.

Free Community Programming

We serve our community by providing FREE, fun, family-friendly programming all year! These all-level, all-ages and abilities activities invite local organizations, artists, and service providers to collaborate with our Programming Team to host weekly classes and large-scale cultural community festivals. In 2022, we partnered with 200+ incredible Austin nonprofits and businesses, serving 80,000 guests at 120 programs.

Weekly Programming

Wellness Classes · Spring & Fall

A variety of 85 of body-moving, mind-rejuvenating health and wellness classes got Waterloo Park moving in 2022, presented with community partners Castle Hill Fitness, Esquina Tango, and Aging is Cool. Guests of all-ages and abilities are always welcome to join!

Morning Glories & Wild Wednesdays · Spring, Summer, & Fall

Weekly early childhood education series providing hands-on and STEAM activities to promote literacy, cultural learnings, and nature play. Each week featured a different style of play from our partners including Armstrong Community Music School, Dance Waterloo, Families in Nature, and Texas Book Festival during 35 educational programs.

Tales on the Trail · Summer & Fall

Guided leisurely park tours explored the community history and natural features that have shaped the landscape of Waterloo Park. Topics included the sustainable design and construction of Moody Amphitheater, Central Texas medicinal and healing plants, and Indigenous Peoples' Day.

Community Festivals

MXTX: A Cross Border Exchange · April

Featured a mixed chamber ensemble and DJ performance with 12 unique pieces of music created through the collaborative exchange of 40 DJ-producers and composers from both sides of the Rio Grande, in partnership with Golden Hornet and Fusebox. An estimated 2,000 visitors enjoyed family-friendly activities and an intersectional BIPOC, Queer, Latinx, and local creatives-centered mercado y más hosted by Frida Friday ATX.

Waterloo Green Day · April

Featured 35+ interactive exhibits, hands-on workshops, live mural paintings, environmental panel discussion, live music, and birds of prey flight showcase that welcomed 2,500 guests. Waterloo Greenway's Earth Day centered conversations around climate change, alternative energy, water sustainability, overpopulation, Central Texas biodiversity, waterway pollution and restoration, and environmental justice in collaboration with Planet Texas 2050.

Rainbow on the Creek · June

Community Pride Month celebration featuring a free family-friendly Pride Festival & Celebration with live music, dance, and drag performances from local LGBTQIA+ artists that welcomed 3,000 visitors to Waterloo Park. The festival included 25+ exhibits from Austin's LGBTQIA+ nonprofits, business, and gender affirming and sexual health service providers.

Friday Flicks · Summer

Waterloo Park hosted three beloved summertime movies including Sing 2, Spider-Man: No Way Home, and Selena in partnership with Austin Parks Foundation and Alamo Drafthouse Cinema. An estimated 8,000 total visitors enjoyed audience contests, live music, and family-friendly activities at each screening.

Día de los Muertos · November

Día de los Muertos, or Day of the Dead, traditionally celebrated in Mexico, is a holiday now celebrated globally to honor departed loved ones. During a two-day celebration Waterloo Park featured 20+ local Latinx nonprofits & organizations, community altars, live music, and family-friendly activities that welcomed over 6,000 attendees.

Creek Show · November

Waterloo Greenway's largest community event featuring nine immersive light-based art installations created by eight teams of local artists, landscape architects, and designers. Throughout the free 10-night event, thousands of community members of all ages enjoyed live music by 46 local performers, 50+ community partner booths, and a variety of family-friendly activities at Waterloo Park.

Waterloo Park is home to Austin's newest outdoor performance venue, Moody Amphitheater. Featuring a capacity of up to 5,000 music fans, with food & beverage concessions, and VIP lounge and rooftop spaces available. In 2022, Waterloo Greenway hosted 24 national touring shows, in collaboration with C3 Presents/Live Nation. We welcomed top talent with the likes of H.E.R., Olivia Rodrigo, Ray LaMontagne, Phoebe Bridgers, Brandi Carlile, Father John Misty, Gloria Trevi, and many more!

Each season, our community can enter to win FREE seats to each show as part of our commitment to making the arts accessible to all. In 2022, thousands of fans took advantage of this unique program made possible through a partnership between Waterloo Greenway and C3 Presents/ Live Nation.

Looking Ahead

Waterloo Park has become an amazing testament to show the potential of our park system – but it's only the beginning! The next phase of Waterloo Greenway, The Confluence, breaks ground this spring to connect 4th Street to Lady Bird Lake. In collaboration with the City of Austin, we celebrated the selection of construction partner, Jay-Reese Contractors, in 2023. Extensive work will include creek reconstruction to stabilize eroded slopes, creating habitats for wildlife and plants, and improved mobility with new bridges and trails. The lush new landscape will feature nearly 1,550 trees, 200,000 mature plants, and 10 acres of seed mixes at the southernmost point of Waterloo Greenway.
