


Monstrum play equipment currently under development in Detroit riverfront park

"Shade and materials such as grills to prepare food; tables and chairs"

"Space for cultural events"

"Family friendly spaces to gather"

"BBQ, picnics, parties - birthdays, music, reunions, celebrations"

"Smaller, more flexible features to allow more informal, community-driven activities"

"Terrace seating"

"Smaller areas for family gatherings and individual seating"

"Some sort of deck"

"Being able to spend quality time with family and friends"

"Picnic tables that can be moved around but also well-maintained"


"Eat and drink, share stories, laugh"

"Moveable seating, ability to shift around"






A "halo" roof floating over the structure offers numerous benefits including more shade, natural air circulation, and highlighting the craft of the original stonework





Light can be reflected off of the halo's underside for better lighting around the shelter house for safety and atmosphere













## Four Square/ Activity Pad
